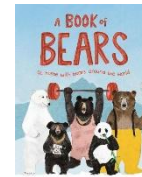
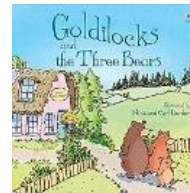
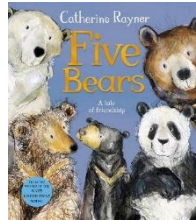

Writing

Our Writing will be based on the books Five Bears and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We will teach

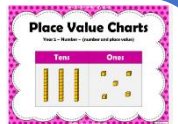
Phonics in groups every day and teach handwriting four days a week. This term the focus will be on the use of capital letters and full stops, and the use of adjectives. We will be writing descriptions of the bears, creating posters, and writing lists and instructions.

Reading

Children will read every day as part of their Phonics lesson. Each day we will share books to develop the children's love of reading.

This term we will focus on counting and securing our understanding of numbers to 20 and developing our knowledge of place value. Then we will move onto addition and subtraction within 20.

PE - Important Information.

Homework.

PE



In PE we this term we will be learning to play Hand Ball the aim of the game is to pass a ball using your hands, then throw the ball into the other team's goal. Our second session will focus on Throwing and Catching, children will learn ball handling skills. They will learn to control a ball when they are rolling and bouncing, throwing and catching, on their own and with a partner and in a group.

Geography

We will learn directional language and create a map of the bears' house and the route Goldilocks would need to take to get there. We will do a survey about how we travel to school.
