We have had another fantastic week again with lots of learning being brought to life, and being brought off of the page. In Little Gems they have enjoyed reading the magic porridge pot. The children really enjoyed making their own porridge. Opal class enjoyed investigating which materials, would be best to build a bridge from. They used weights (metal coins) to see how much weight each bridge could hold, before it collapsed.



Jade class really enjoyed acting out a French bakery this week. We were very impressed how they could all hold a conversation in French to order a croissant, and then explain which condiments they would like on top. C'est super! Excellent travail, cours de Jade. They have also been linking their Geography into the book 'Idia'; the children were fascinated to see a yam in real life. They made African kingdoms from Lego as well as African dolls from clay.





In Moonstone class we have been thinking about life during WW2. The children wrote some fantastic poems in role as an evacuee. using charcoal, they created some very moving drawings of soldiers, aeroplanes and air raid shelters. They also looked at some evacuee artefacts and thought about what they would take, if they were evacuated to the countryside.

We have had lots of new families visit the school this week. I must say, it has been an absolute pleasure to show them around. The children have all been so, polite, friendly and have talked about all the wonderful things they are learning about. In collective worship, we have begun thinking about world religions day, which will be celebrated on Sunday 18th January.
