Parking request

We have recently seen an increase in the number of concerns expressed by parents and members of the wider community regarding parking near school, particularly around school drop-off and collection times. The worsening parking situation is now regularly compromising the safety of our children and local residents.

Please can we ask you to park thoughtfully, avoiding the double yellow lines and zig zags which are there to protect children near the road entrance to the school, and to treat the front of school as pedestrian-only during peak school movement times.

We would like to ask you to consider parking slightly further out from school and walking in, to alleviate pressure on the main junction and bend – there is also discretionary space at the car park by the church and cricket field.

I will be contacting our local PCO policing team, to discuss if they can provide more effective enforcement of parking on the main road during school-run times.
