



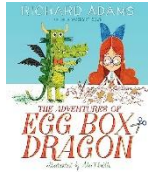

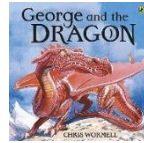

 **Writing**
Our writing will be based on the Egg Box Dragon and the story of George and the Dragon. The children will be writing dragon stories, writing instructions for making an egg box dragon, writing character descriptions and descriptions of castles and writing invitations, the focus will continue to be on the use of capital letters and full stops and the use of adjectives. Phonics will be taught in groups and handwriting will be taught every day.

Reading
Children will read in a group every day as part of their Phonics lesson, they will bring home a RWI book bag book which will match their Phonic Group level, these are changed on a Monday.

Maths
This term we will be working on length and height, Fractions and Mass and Volume.

Science

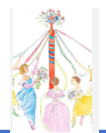
