Writing

Our writing will be based on Journey a picture book. We will be creating a sequel to the story to publish. On Thursday and Friday we will be focusing on different grammatical techniques we can include in our writing.



Reading

Children will have whole class guided reading sessions where children can deepen their understanding of the text and their level of comprehension. Children have various opportunities to read independently and with others in the class and discuss their reading. There will also be weekly comprehension.



Maths

This term we will be continuing looking at fractions. We will be adding and subtracting fractions and answer reasoning questions. We will then move on to our time unit.

PE - Important Information
