

Dear Parents and Carers,

Hello and welcome back! We hope you all had a brilliant Easter holiday and enjoyed some well-deserved rest and time together.

We are very excited for the summer term ahead. It was lovely to see some sunny weather during the holidays, and we are hopeful that this will continue into the coming weeks as we move into a busy and enjoyable term.

Here is some key information for this term. All curriculum information has been sent out, so please do refer to this. If you have any questions, please do come and speak to one of us.

Homework this term will be set as follows: spelling homework will go home on a Wednesday afternoon and should be returned by the following Tuesday. The children will then be tested on the words at the top of the sheet on the Wednesday of the following week. Maths homework will be sent out every Friday and should be returned by the following Thursday. We also encourage you to continue reading with your child at least five times a week, as this has a significant impact on their progress.

The multiplication check is fast approaching for our Year 4 children, so please continue practising as much as possible at home. We will be sending out another letter explaining how to log into Google Classroom, where children can access practice tests and games. All children also have an EdShed login for spelling games; we will resend these details, but please do ask your child so you can support additional practice at home.

We have May Day at the end of this term, which is always such a lovely occasion and something the children really enjoy.

There are also lots of optional activities you could do at home with your child. These include baking cakes, creating a 3D model of something in Wootton (linked to our Geography topic), designing a shoebox scene of a journey they would like to go on, writing diary entries about their term, or planting flowers, fruit, or vegetables and recording how they grow. Gardening together is also a great way to support learning.
