Max Card is a discount card for SEND children. It can be used at venues across the UK to get free or discounted admission. In Oxfordshire, Max Card is run in partnership between Carers Oxfordshire and the Oxfordshire Children, Education and Families Directorate.

It can be used in some of the UK's top attractions including Legoland Windsor, Thorpe Park, Madame Tussauds London, and the Sealife Aquarium in London. Local attractions that take part in Oxfordshire include The Story Museum in Oxford, Snakes and Ladders in Abingdon, Millets Farm Falconry Centre in Frilford, The River and Rowing Museum in Henley, Ariel extreme in Milton Keynes and Bicester Bowl.

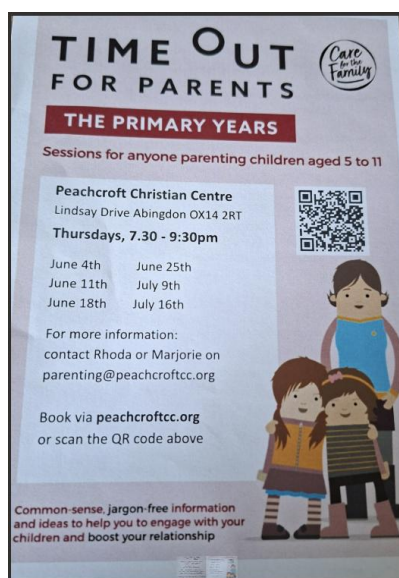
