Writing

Our writing this term will be linked to the novel *The Philosopher's Stone* by J K Rowling. We will write letters to Harry, create an advert for a new magic wand, and write a match report for a game of quidditch.



Reading

This term we will focus on whole class shared reading where children can deepen their understanding of the text and their level of comprehension. We will focus on extending their vocabulary using words from a range of texts. Also we will work on comprehension skills, look at authors choice of language and interpreting texts.



Maths

This term we will be working on position and direction, looking at the four quadrants on coordinate grids. We will investigate how to solve problems with missing coordinates. We will then move on to shape.

PE - Important Information.

PE is on a **Wednesday and Friday** all children must have a PE kit, which is a white (or house coloured) T-shirt, black shorts or joggers and trainers.

Homework.

Homework will be sent out on a Friday and is due in on Thursday. The children will be set weekly spellings and some work based upon what we have done in class that week. Please take time to work with your child, to help them with anything they're finding difficult.

Reading at Home.

Children are encouraged to take chapter books home from our class library. Please try to read with your child as much as possible, taking time to talk about the plot, what has happened and the genre of the book. Children will be expected to read daily and record in the back of their homework book.



History

This term we will be looking at how leisure and entertainment has changed over the past century. We will be looking at the introduction of cinemas – you might like to watch an old movie together at home.

Science

Our topic will be forces. Each week we will be completing an experiment, where will we plan it thinking about how to make it a fair test. We will investigate different forces in action. We have lots of exciting experiments to carry out this term.

Design Technology

We will be designing and making our own mechanical fairground model. We will use electrical components to enable them to move and rotate.

Please bring in lots of tubes, toilet rolls and cereal boxes ready for our building project

ICT

We will be looking at sensing movement. We will look at micro:bits and program them to sense movement. They will design and make a step counter. Finally they will look at evaluating at quiz.

PSHE

Our topic this term is 'Being my Best'. We will explore different scenarios and look at the risks whiting them. We will also be running 'mock trails', where two magistrates will come in to lead.

Music

We will be writing our own lyrics to songs, focusing on the amount of syllables in a line as well as rhyme. We will practice for our show 'Wootton's Got Talent' and learning some songs in preparation.

RE

In our discovery RE session, we will be learning about the religion of Sikhism. Our key question will be: What is the best way for a Sikh to show commitment to God?
