A message from the DfE:

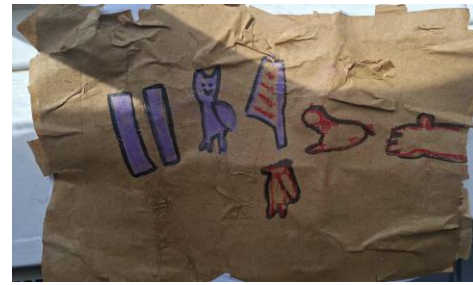
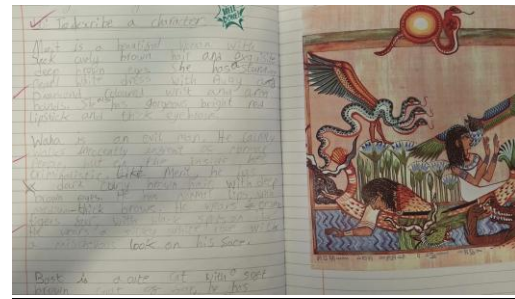

Sadly we won't be able to share the results until 16th July. We will have more updates soon.

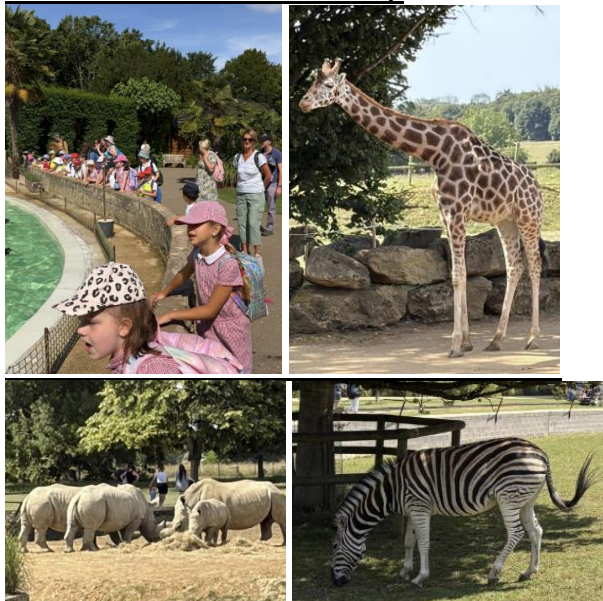
