**Class 3 –** Archie Rowland for settling in well and listening to what he has to do.

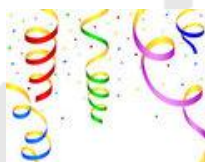
**Class 4 -** Erin Tonks for being very responsible by helping people in class as well as the infant children.
